You should cut your wood to the most efficient length for your purpose, in terms of both handling and storing it, as well as making it a suitable length for your application.

Short logs can be split into firewood using a steel wedge and sledgehammer, but it's a slow process that requires two people. A maul combines a sledgehammer with a wedge in one tool. It's heavy, but does a good job of splitting logs. A splitting axe is similar to a maul, but it has a narrower, lighter head that easily slices through logs.

It's a lot easier to move and split dry, seasoned logs than it is to split fresh "green" logs that are denser because they're full of sap. Besides, instead of burning for a nice, long time, green wood tends to just smoke briefly before the flame dies out. Firewood is split primarily to encourage faster drying. When a tree is first cut down and processed into several whole logs, it typically contains a high moisture content. In fact, the moisture content of fresh or green firewood can exceed 100%. At 100%, firewood contains half of its weight in water.
